
STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2023-24 (EVEN SEMESTER)

1.Topics covered in the curriculum and syllabi of the courses are relevant for life and are sufficient ²⁸⁴ responses




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2. Extent of syllabi covered in the class are sufficient to attend the internal exams (CIA) 284 responses

3. Course delivery by the faculty member in the class are interesting, interactive and participative $^{284\, responses}$






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4.Percentage usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching 284 responses

5. Fairness in the assessment processes (CAI, QUIZ Assignments,etc) 284 responses






6.Internal exam schedule portions evaluations and announcement of results

7.Opportunities in the institution for Research Activities 284 responses



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
8. Opportunity to participate in events outside, extra curricular activities (Sports, Fine Arts) 284 responses

284 responses


