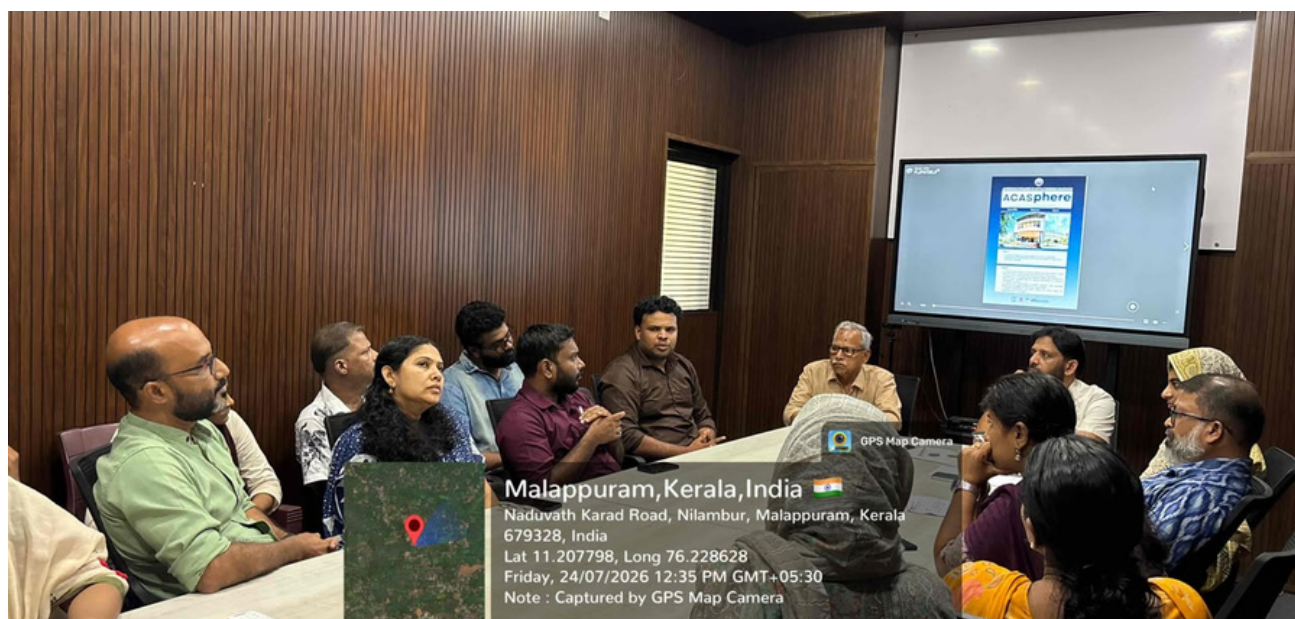

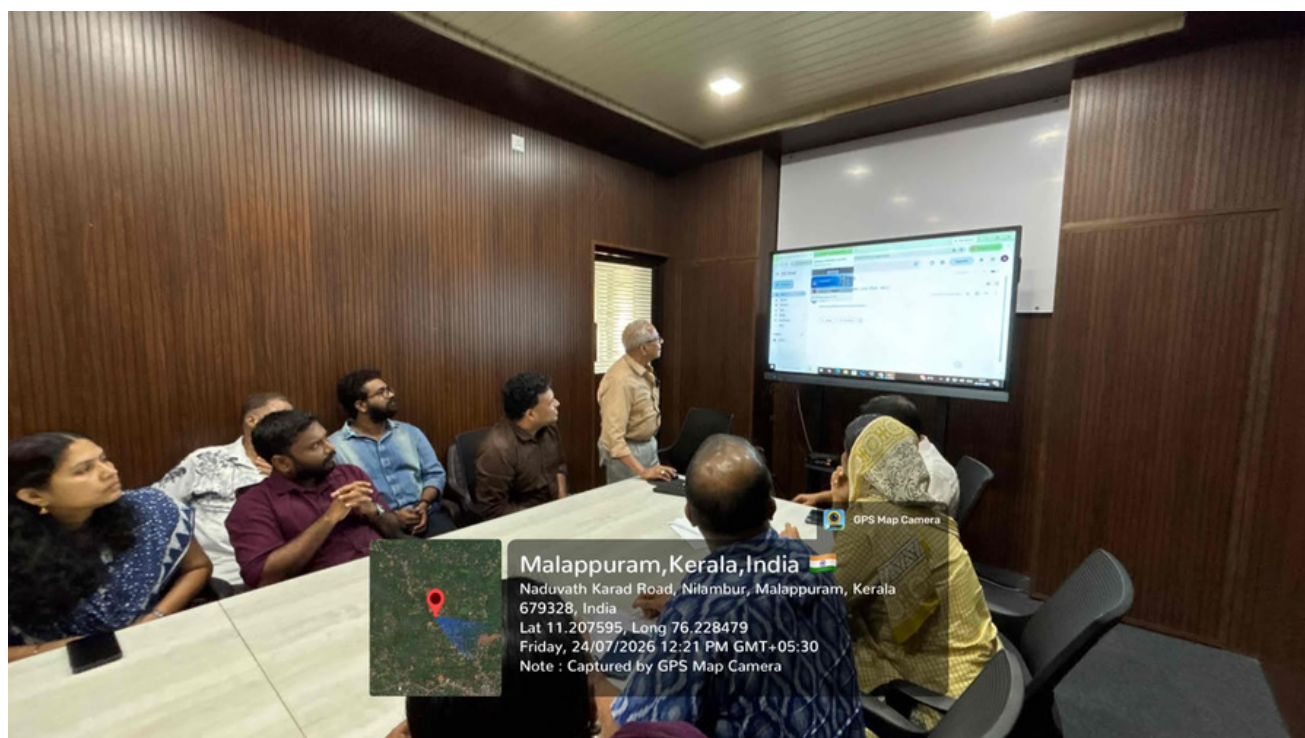
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Launch of 'Acasphere' Newsletter

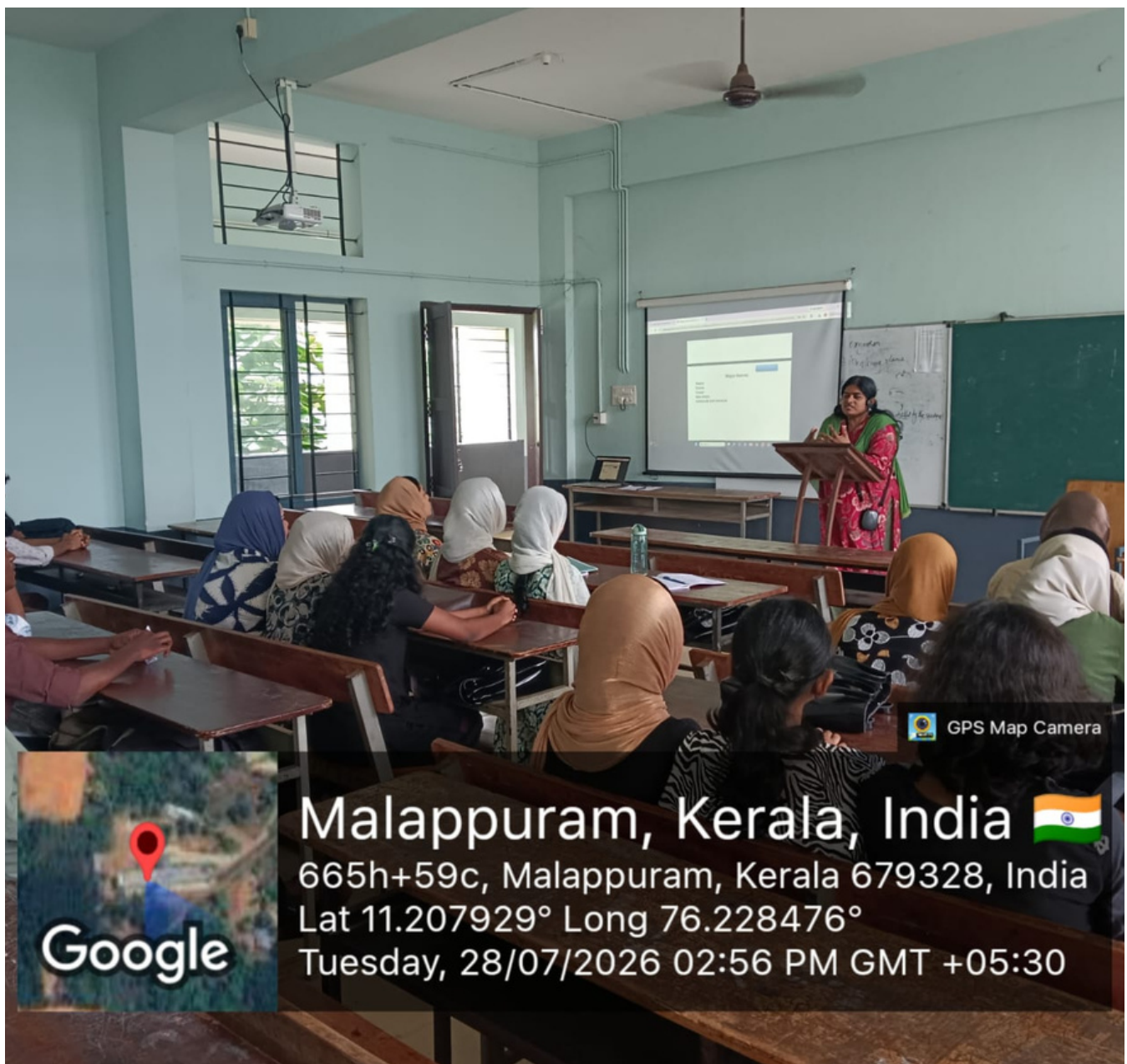
Book Bank

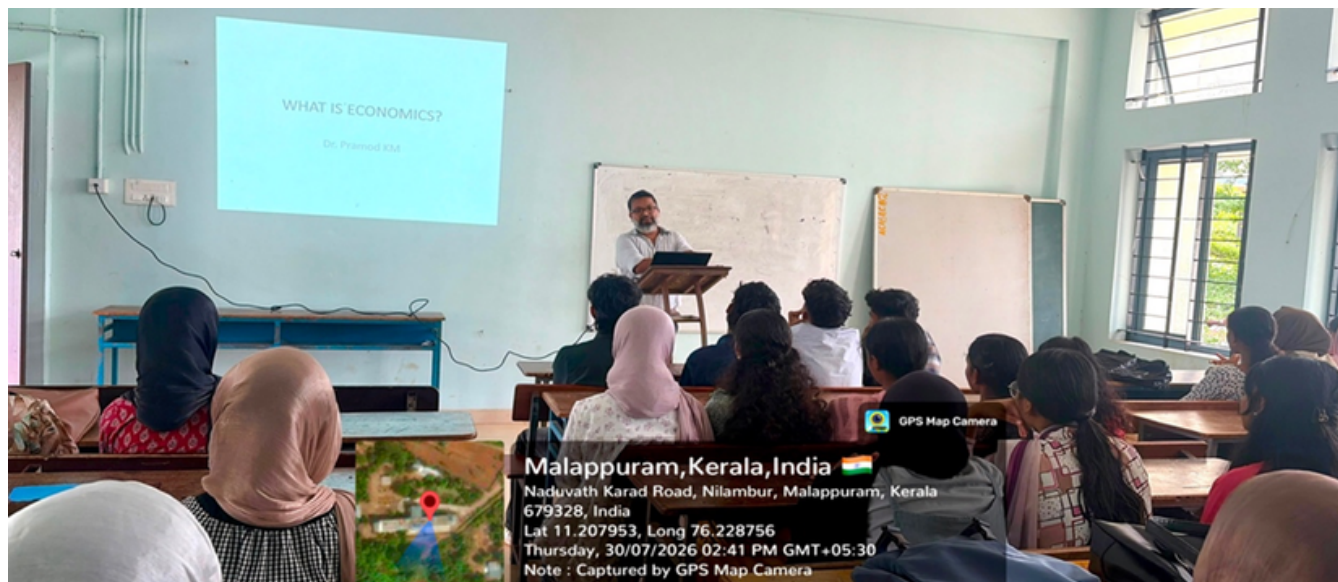
Bridge Courses by the Department of English

The Department of English, Ambedkar College of Arts & Science, Wandoor, organised the Cambridge Bridge Course 2026 for the 2026 batch of B.A. English Language & Literature Honours students. The programme was conducted on 27 July 2026 as an introductory academic programme to familiarise newly admitted students with the fundamental concepts and areas of English language and literature. The course covered important topics including Introduction to English Language and Literature, Literary Genres, Periods of English Literature, Literary Terms, Literary Movements, Literary Criticism and Theory, Figures of Speech and Poetic/Literary Devices, and Poetic Appreciation. The programme was designed to provide students with a strong foundation before they formally engage with the undergraduate English curriculum. It helped introduce the students to the basic terminology, concepts, movements, genres, and critical approaches that form an essential part of literary studies. The Bridge Course reflects the Department of English's commitment to facilitating a smooth transition of students into higher education and preparing them for the academic demands of the B.A. English Language & Literature Honours programme. The initiative also provided an opportunity for students to develop an initial orientation towards the study and appreciation of English language and literature.

Butterfly Garden – An Initiative in Gardening



As part of its environmental and nature-conservation activities, the NSS Unit of Ambedkar College of Arts and Science, Wandoor, organised a programme on “Butterfly Garden – An Initiative in Gardening” on 14 July 2026 at 12:00 PM in the Clubs and Associations Room under the guidance of Mr. Shibily, Environmentalist, with the active participation of NSS volunteers. The programme aimed to introduce students to the concept of butterfly-friendly gardening and encourage them to create environmentally sustainable spaces that support butterflies and other beneficial organisms. The major objectives were to create awareness about the ecological importance of butterflies, introduce the concept and significance of butterfly gardens, promote gardening and environmental conservation, encourage the cultivation of flowering and nectar-producing plants suitable for butterflies, provide habitats for butterflies and other pollinating insects, conserve biodiversity within the college campus, develop environmental responsibility and sustainable gardening practices among students, and motivate NSS volunteers to participate actively in nature-conservation activities. During the interactive session, Mr. Shibily explained the vital role of butterflies in pollination and biodiversity conservation and discussed the essential requirements for establishing and maintaining a butterfly garden, including the selection of appropriate host and nectar plants, adequate sunlight, water, shelter, and a pesticide-free environment. He also stressed the importance of avoiding harmful chemical pesticides and adopting eco-friendly gardening practices to protect butterflies and other beneficial insects. The volunteers were encouraged to observe butterflies in their natural habitats and understand their contribution to maintaining ecological balance. The programme successfully enhanced environmental awareness among the participants and inspired them to undertake sustainable gardening initiatives that contribute to biodiversity conservation and the protection of nature.



Orientation and Registration on Digital Workforce Management System (DWMS)

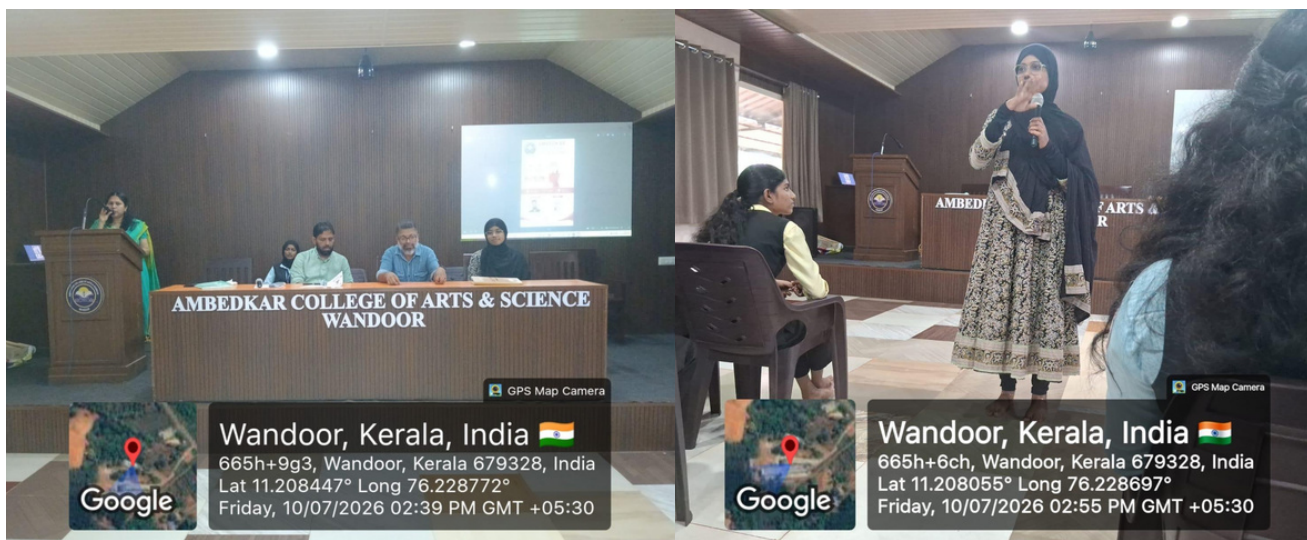
Workshop on Adobe Premiere Pro

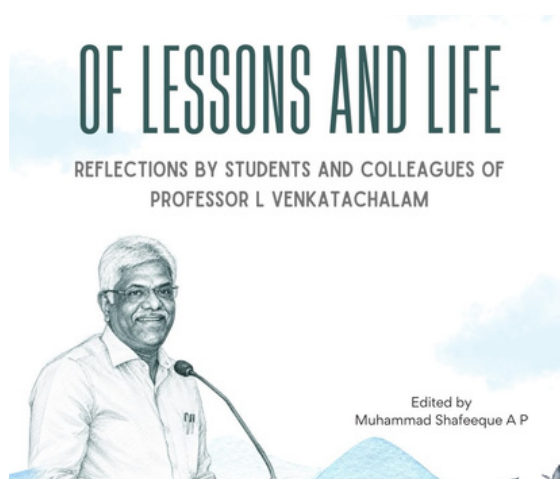
Faculty attended Short Term Course

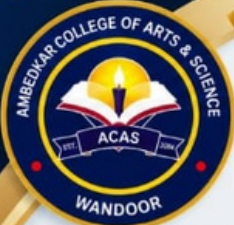
